Using a Kenedy ISD issued Chromebook

Connecting Chromebook to School Network (school parking lot)

If you need to use the Kenedy ISD school network, you may park in the secondary parking lot near the building. When you open your chromebook, the chromebook will automatically connect to the internet. Please stay in your vehicle and avoid congregating.

Turning Your Chromebook On (at home)

Turn on your chrome book (opening sometimes automatically turns on chromebook)



- *if it does not power on, please make sure it is charged or has a charger plugged in
- If this is your first time logging in from home or on a mobile hotspot you will see the following screen



- Click Add Other WiFi Network
- Find your home WiFi network Connect to your home Wifi Network or Hotspot (instructions on setting up a hotspot on next page)

Connecting Chromebook to Wifi (home internet, mobile hotspot)

To connect to the Internet, use a compatible Wi-Fi network.

Turn on Wi-Fi

- 1. At the bottom right, select the time.
- Select Not Connected .
 Note: If you see your Wi-Fi network name and a signal strength, your Chromebook is already connected to Wi-Fi.
- 3. Turn on Wi-Fi.
- 4. Your Chromebook will automatically look for available networks and show them to you in a list.
- 5. Choose the name of your desired network and, if prompted, enter your router/hotspot username and password to connect.


Mobile Hotspots (Personal)

Turning on Mobile Hotspot (iPhone)


If you do not have internet (wifi) at home, and want to activate the hotspot on your phone to connect to the internet, please follow these instructions.

Data rates with your mobile provider will apply


• Click on the Settings icon

• Turn on Allow Others To Join




 You hot spot is now active and your hotspot password is displayed in the section "WiFi Password:"

Turning On Mobile Hotspot (Android)


If you do not have internet (wifi) at home, and want to activate your phones hotspot to connect to the internet, please follow the instructions below.

Data rates with your mobile provider will apply

- Open your phone settings
- Select "Connections"




• Next Select Mobile Hotspot and Tethering



• Turn Mobile Hotspot ON




• Your mobile hotspot is now on. You will be able to see what your hotspot name is and the password to connect to it.




Logging into Your Kenedy ISD Chromebook

You may see several different login screens on your Kenedy ISD issued Chromebooks. We have issued out two different brands: Lenovo and Asus. Each has a different model number and they automatically update the operating system software. Your screens may look different than the images you see in this guidance document.

 Once you connect to your home wifi, mobile hotspot, or school wifi, you will see a login screen as follows.





- Click Next (sometimes you will be required to sign in multiple times)
- Login into your chromebook with your Student ID @kenedyisd.com
 (ie #####@kenedyisd.com)

• At the next login screen you will have to log into our system using just your student ID as the user name (only numbers #####) and password (no @kenedyisd.com on this page)




*TIP: IF YOU SEE THIS TYPE OF LOGIN SCREEN, YOUR USERNAME IS JUST YOUR STUDENT ID. IF YOU SEE A GOOGLE LOGO ON THE LOGIN SCREEN YOU MUST PUT @KENEDYISD.COM AFTER YOUR STUDENT ID.

- Then press Login
- You are now officially logged into your google apps account.

Basic introduction into logging into your Google Apps for Education (GAFE) accounts:









Google Classroom Help

Logging into Google Classroom on iPad, Tablet, or mobile device

1. Download the Google Classroom app. It is available on iOS and Android devices.



2. Open the app and click Get Started button




3. Sign in OR if other users are logged in already, click "Add account" Your email address is:

(xxxxx = your student ID)



Sign In and Join a Classroom (Website or Chromebook)

- 1. Ways to get to Google Classroom:
 - A) Open internet browser.
 - Type https://classroom.google.com OR
 - B) If already logged into Google or your Chromebook, click on the "waffle" at the top right corner to open the Google apps




2. Log in with your @kenedyisd.com (Siblings sharing a computer will have to log out siblings account)




If you are already signed into Google, click the Apps menu and choose *Classroom* from the list of apps.Enter your credentials and sign into your account.

Resources for remote learning

Chromebook Protection Do's and Don'ts

Protect the Chromebook screen by following the rules below:

- The Chromebook screen can be damaged if subjected to rough treatment.
 Chromebooks are particularly sensitive to damage from excessive pressure on the screen.
- Close the Chromebook screen before moving it. (Don't walk around with an open chromebook)
- Do not lean on the top of the Chromebook when it is closed.
- Do not place anything near the Chromebook that could put pressure on the screen.
- Do not poke the screen.
- Do not place anything on the keyboard before closing the lid (e.g. pens, pencils, or disks).
- Clean the screen with a soft, dry cloth or anti-static cloth.
- Do not bump the Chromebook against walls, car doors, floors, etc. as it will eventually break the screen.
- No food or drink is allowed next to your Chromebook while it is in use. This could damage the computer beyond repair.
- To conserve battery life Chromebooks should be shut down before moving them and when finished using the computer.
- Chromebooks must remain free of any writing, drawing, stickers, or labels that are not the property of Kenedy ISD.
- Chromebooks must never be left in an unlocked car or any unsupervised area.
 Students are responsible for charging their Chromebook's battery
